

## TIM REDOVIAN SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA 2012

The Tim Redovian Fund, Inc. was established in memory of Tim Redovian, (DeKalb Center for the Performing Arts Class of 1998) who died November 6, 1996 from complications of viral pneumonia. The Tim Redovian Summer Scholarship is open to students who wish to attend programs to further their training in drama, voice, instrument, or dance who meet the following requirements:

### SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Student must currently be a freshman, sophomore or junior in high school.
- Student must have a 3.0 or better cumulative grade point average (GPA).
- Student must include an official copy of his/her current transcript of grades.
- Student must include a copy of his/her current resume.
- Student must submit a completed application that is signed by both the student AND his/her parent or legal guardian.
- Student must include one letter of recommendation from a **performing arts teacher**.
- Student must write an essay discussing how this summer program will benefit him or her.
- The chosen program must be “hands on” and include training and classroom time.
- Student must submit written information or a brochure that describes the program he/she wishes to attend.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- **Complete application packets must be submitted by mail and postmarked no later than February 24 to: Stephanie Singletary 145 15<sup>th</sup> St., NE Atlanta, GA 30309**
- **No late or incomplete applications will be accepted for consideration.**
- **Applications that do not meet all of the above criteria will not be considered.**
- **A \$20 non-refundable application fee must be submitted with the application.** The application fee can be paid via check made payable to Tim Redovian Memorial Fund, OR via credit card through a donation at [www.timredovian.org](http://www.timredovian.org). Please note your payment confirmation number (if paid by credit card through TRMF) on your application form where indicated.

An audition will be scheduled for **Saturday, March 24, 2012**. All auditions will take place in the **black box theatre at the Alliance Theatre** on Peachtree Street. The Scholarship Committee will randomly select the order and set up an audition schedule, which will be posted on the Redovian Web Site ([www.timredovian.org](http://www.timredovian.org)) by **Sunday, March 11, 2012**.

Each student must prepare an audition piece of your choice no longer than 5 minutes. Students applying to musical theatre programs should prepare 2 pieces (i.e. one song and one monologue or one song and one dance piece) that total 5 minutes. Judges will be committee selected performing arts professionals from the community and scholarship board members.

Students will be judged in three categories:

- 1) Personal Presentation: introduction of self and explanation of audition material with a short question/answer session.
- 2) Artistic Presentation: the performance, preparation and difficulty of audition material.
- 3) Personal Essay: content and style.

Winners will be notified via phone and/or email provided on application form. Monies received in the form of a scholarship will be paid directly to the student's chosen program upon verification of acceptance and intent to attend the program (including flight confirmation, if applicable).
