When Tim was in high school he attended the DeKalb Center for the Performing Arts at Avondale High School (now DeKalb School of the Arts) where he was a member of the National Honor Society and a participant in the Governor's Honors Program, all the while staying busy learning dance, voice and drama, anything that would get him seen on stage.

Tragically, Tim's dream was cut short. At the very early age of 16, he died suddenly from complications of viral pneumonia. At that time, Tim was already a working theatrical professional with many credits to his name. It was clear then, as it is now, that Tim's dream had to keep on shining.
